




THE VILLA

Situated in a rural and unpretentious area, and surround by villages with a fantastic number of restaurants, or easy access to the coast.









Saint-Paul-en-Forêt

Saint-Paul-en-Forêt resides on the edge of the Esterel mountains.

The area offers walkers authentic streets and alleys and can be the starting points for walks through the wonderful forest to Lake Rioutard amongst pine, white oak, and cork trees. Besides nature trails, the lake offers bass, carp, roach, pike fishing.

The village became independent of Fayence in 1824 and was traditionally a producer of heather brooms. The village glass factory was prosperous until 1974 and visited by Queen Jeanne who gave name to the big glass bottle - La Dame-Jeanne, often placed in a basket with two handles.

The Chapel of St. Joseph consecrated in 1030 was destroyed in 1884 during the route of the Draguignan road and replaced by The Church of St. Paul (XVIII). The church has a square bell tower and an ancient wooden statue of St. Paul, believed to have the power to ward off hail.

From time immemorial, its brightness and its dazzling beauty have inspired the greatest masters in fields as varied as architecture, painting, music or cinema.


The unspoiled shoreline is turned towards the Mediterranean and its pleasures: creeks and sea-beds rhyme with sailing, water skiing or scuba diving.

The cities that dot it are in effervescence day and night: gastronomy, shopping, culture, events, everything is there!










9.3 KM Gorges du Blavet



11.9 KM Gordes


Considered one of France's most beautiful villages, Gordes is a remote delight amid the rugged landscapes of the Luberon Regional Nature Park. Cobbled streets and golden stone houses wind their way around a mountaintop, culminating in the majestic 16th-century château. The village has been home to several celebrated French painters, including André Lhote, Marc Chagall, Jean Deyrolle, Victor Vasarely and Pol Mara.

12.9 км Parc Zoologique de Fréjus

In a wooded park typical of the Mediterranean (12 different species of palm trees, centuriesold olive trees, various varieties of citrus fruits, mimosas, succulents and aromatic plants), enjoy a beautiful family walk and meet nearly 500 wild animals of 95 different species. A visit to the Fréjus Zoological Park is a moment of relaxation in a beautiful setting, but also a way to better understand the animal world and the importance of ensuring its preservation.



13.7 км Massif de l'Esterel


Bordered on one side by the Mediterranean and on the other by the limestone Provence, if there were only one side left, the Esterel massif would be the must-see! Its characteristic red rock and abrupt reliefs give all its charm to the landscape of the territory. You will fall under his spell, we guarantee it! Hikers, riders, mountain bikers... 32,000 hectares of nature and various trails are wating for you!



14.2 км Mont Vinaigre

Mont Vinaigre reaches to only 618m but has a dramatic setting as the highest point in the Massif, overlooking the Mediterranean Sea and in the distance you get fine views of Cannes. It's located in the centre of the Massif de l'Esterel, just north of Fréjus and accessible by road off the N7.

18.7 км Luna Park Frejus

Luna Park Fréjus is a giant carnival located on the road between Frejus and Saint-Aygulf. It's a magical place that will entertain both young and old. On the program you will find thrilling rides such as the Magic Mountain or the Ferris wheel, carousels, ghost trains, bumper cars and many more. A mini-park is 100% dedicated to younger children with unlimited access to the fun facilities there.



19.2 KM Parasailing Saint Raphael

Directly from the Vieux Port of Saint Raphael, board for parasailing flights. Board for your parasail flight directly from the Vieux Port. At one, two, three, or even four, enjoy an unforgettable panorama over the bay of St Raphael. Take the height under our parachute and admire the horizon. Between sky and sea, enjoy the coastline of Provence that is just under your eyes.



Porquerolles

This island is found off the coast of Toulon. While it is still relatively unfrequented by tourists, it has a huge amount to offer, including gleaming beaches, exotic plant life, sparkling, transparent waters and is one of the most peaceful environments imaginable. The island has a selection of hotels and restaurants to suit all budgets and plays host to popular cultural events, including yearly jazz and sailing festivals. Porquerolles is another magical hideaway to explore.

Markets in Provence

Brightly-colored vegetables spill forth from the stands. Cheesemakers offer tastes of their most recent experiments alongside the varieties they've carefully perfected for 20 years. The aroma of roasted chicken drifts through the air while locals arrive for their daily baguettes. A vendor helps a customer choose the perfect scarf to take home. The ambiance at weekly markets-particularly at a Provence market-is addictive.

Provence market days are every day of the week, depending on what town you visit. Most markets in Provence are temporary, outdoor markets that take place once or twice a week. They are generally in the main town square but can sprawl down streets and even into other squares, especially on Saturdays. In certain places, like Aix-en-Provence and Uzes, it can feel like the whole town has become part of the market. Heaven.

L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue

Formerly a nautical village, L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue is now a major attraction for antiques lovers and anyone wishing to experience the scenery of a bygone era. It hosts vibrant traditional markets every Sunday and its yearly antiques fair is considered to be one of the best in the world. Over 450 dealers come laden with curiosities, making for hours of fascinating browsing for those who love learning about the art and fashions of the past. Even if the fair is not for you, you can explore the classic riverside cafés, the quaint clusters of shops or the winding stretches of water with their historic boats, which have earned the town its nickname of 'the Venice of Provence'.



Aix-en-Provence

Aix-en-Provence, France, is a stunning city dotted with plane trees and fountains and overflowing with joie de vivre. The twisted lanes in Aix lead to squares that host some of the best markets of Provence many days of the week. If you visit Aix-en-Provence on a Tuesday, Thursday, or Saturday, you can have your pick from anything in the farmer's market, the flower market, the antiques market, the fruit and vegetable market, or the textiles market. It's an embarrassment of riches.
